

Hygiene and fire protection rules

The following rules apply to our event “Nantou – Streitende Reiche”. They were created in coordination with the specifications of the venue and the responsible authorities. The rules are for your safety and must be observed. If you do not want to accept and follow the rules, please stay at home. Thank you for your support and understanding!

You can find explanations for the implementation of the rules in the game below and in other situations.

1. A minimum distance of 1.5 m must always be maintained between all persons present. (This does not apply to members of the same household.)
2. Mouth and nose protection (MNS) must be worn in all indoor areas (houses, closed tents) and in all places with a high number of people (check-in, cooking areas, possible queues). Each person should always carry an MNS with them on the event site so that they can use it immediately if necessary. We generally recommend always wearing an MNS.
3. All interior rooms must be ventilated regularly, preferably permanently.
4. There should never be more than 3 people together in the same room (houses, closed tents). Only a maximum of one person is allowed in the toilet and shower rooms as well as in the indoor kitchen. (This does not apply to members of the same household.) The assigned sleeping places should not be swapped.
5. Body contact with one another must be avoided. Likewise, avoid touching your face with your hands. Pay attention to cough and sneeze etiquette.
6. Washing hands several times a day with soap for at least 20 seconds and regular hand disinfection are strongly recommended. Before and after touching shared objects (e.g. water taps, doorknobs, cookers), it is essential to disinfect your hands and, if possible, the object itself.
7. People who show symptoms of a COVID-19 infection and / or have tested positive for COVID-19 in a suitable test and / or have had contact with infected people and / or have been in a risk area (according to RKI) in the last 2 weeks are excluded from participation.
8. Furthermore, the rules from Appendix 40 of the “Corona Lockerungsverordnung” of the state of Mecklenburg-West Pomerania apply in the version currently valid at the time of the event. [LINK](#)
9. Fire protection: On the grounds of the Slavic village, fire (including candles, smoking, gas cooker) is only permitted at the designated fire places and inside the baking house (shrine) and inside the smithy. No fire is allowed anywhere else.
9. All those participants are requested to accept and sign these rules when entering the event site. In addition, for the purpose of contact tracking by the authorities, the full name, address, date of birth, telephone number, date and time must be correctly registered. In addition, all those present receive mandatory hygiene instructions at the beginning of the event

Notes on the practical implementation of hygiene and fire protection rules

Catering:

We will not be able to offer full catering. That means that all participants have to cater for themselves. Only a few packaged groceries to prepare yourself, which can by no means cover your needs, will be available for you in the Izakaya.

Please note, however, that fires, including gas stoves, are only allowed at the designated fire places. In order to allow you to keep your distance while cooking, we will provide you with several

additional cooking places with electric plates on which you can cook with normal pots. The same rules as everywhere apply here: wear a mask, keep your distance, disinfect devices, surfaces and hands before and after use.

There will be dish washing facilities, as well as a limited amount of disposable dishes / chopsticks from us.

Please do not share dishes and cutlery!

Sanitary rooms:

There are 2 shower rooms and 2 toilet rooms as well as a room with a combined shower + toilet available on site. These may only be used by one person at a time (e.g. 1 in the shower room and 1 in the toilet).

So please avoid long make-up sessions in these rooms. Equip yourself accordingly so that you can put on make-up in your tents. We will also provide you with several mirrors outside that you can use without blocking the sanitary rooms. Maybe take a shower at unusual times to avoid waiting.

Limitation of the number of people indoors

Many of you have complied with our request and will sleep in your own tents. We have been able to reduce the occupancy of the huts so that a maximum of 3 people can be accommodated in one hut and there is sufficient space between them. We ask you to adhere to this limit of 3 people in all closed rooms and to move all your activities to outside as far as possible, or under the open tent roofs, canopies of the houses, etc. Please think about opening the windows and doors as often as possible for fresh, clean air!

Masks (MNS)

Please bring beautiful masks (mouth and nose protection) that match with the setting. A small amount of beautiful and a slightly larger amount of simple black masks will be available at check-in for little money in case you have forgotten your own mask. Always have the mask with you in case you suddenly need it - it is best to always wear it.

(You can take off the mask to sleep when you are at your sleeping place.)

Disinfection

We will provide disinfectants for everyone. Nevertheless, we recommend everyone to bring portable hand disinfectants and always have them with them.

Please disinfect your hands before and after touching shared objects such as faucets, cookers and doorknobs and disinfect these objects before and after use, if possible.

The sanitary rooms and cooking areas are also disinfected several times a day, but in this case it is clear that a lot helps a lot. So help to keep everything clean and to stay clean yourself.

Advice for the ingame situations:

1. Rule of thumb for the correct distance: If two people extend their arms parallel to the floor and barely not touch each other, this is a distance of approx. 1.5 m.

2. Keeping your distance from one another, bowing instead of hugging, not touching, hiding your face to save it and not showing your teeth - all of this is good form in Nantou. So don't hesitate to point this out to other players ingame.

3. Less fight, more threat! Swords and other bladed weapons are potentially deadly in one cut. Accordingly, one should feel threatened by a drawn sword, as if it were a loaded pistol pointed at one's own head - and get away as quickly as possible!

Fights are generally only possible in the form of a duel or a theatrically pre-choreographed and simulated fight, while maintaining the distance. That means you act like you hit each other, but don't actually do it.

Such an arrangement can also be very brief ("We'll surround you now and beat you up, okay?")

Attacks with ranged weapons are still possible. Mouth and nose protection should be worn during all combat operations. After all, a face contorted with pain would be a loss of face.

4. When you hand over objects, it is best to disinfect your hands beforehand and place the object at a distance in front of the recipient (preferably with a bow), then withdraw a little. The recipient can then receive the item while maintaining the distance.

5. Evil number four! Four is an unlucky number in Nantou. So if there is a fourth for every three people in a house, either one or all of them should go outside. Much fresh air drives away evil spirits ;)

6. Telling secrets and conspiratorial meetings at a distance and in the open air are great for the game - this is the only way for others to find out what you are up to and make a story out of it. If you really want to be completely by yourself, the village is big enough that you should find a quiet corner where you can talk to each other from a distance and in peace.

We thank you in advance for your support and help with the implementation of these requirements, which will not only be an obstacle but also an enrichment for the feel of the game in Nantou! We look forward to a safe, all new and exciting event with you.
